

ORDINANCE 2023-185

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF ALEDO, TEXAS, MODIFYING CITY REGULATIONS RELATED TO GROUP E OCCUPANCIES STORM SHELTER REQUIREMENTS; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE IS CUMULATIVE; PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

SECTION 4.

Any person, firm, or corporation who violates, disobeys, omits, neglects, or refuses to comply with or who resists the enforcement of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined not more than Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) for all violations involving zoning, fire, safety, or public health and sanitation, including dumping or refuse, and shall be fined Five hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for all violations of this Ordinance. Each day that a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense.
